NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING CONCERNING AN ADDITIONAL APPROPRIATION OF GRANT COUNTY, INDIANA

Notice is hereby given to the taxpayers of Grant County, Indiana (the "County"), that the County Council will, at its meeting to be held on October 18, 2017, at 6 p.m., local time, in the Grant County Council Chambers, located at 215 South Adams Street, Marion, Indiana, conduct a public hearing on the matter of appropriating the proceeds of bonds of the County, in one or more series, in an amount not to exceed \$8,750,000 (the "Bonds") and any investment earning thereon. The proceeds of the Bonds will be used to finance all or any portion of the following: (i) renovations to the jail, including but not limited to a new generator system; (ii) renovations to the annex; (iii) renovations to the detention center, including but not limited to water infiltration improvements; (iv) renovations to the court house, including but not limited to electrical and mechanical matters and (v) any other related items as determined by the County. The Bonds will also finance all or a portion of the expenses incurred in connection with or on account of the issuance of the Bonds. The Bonds shall have a final maturity no later than twenty (20) years from the date of issuance and shall bear interest at a rate not exceeding 6.0% per annum. Such Bonds will be payable from ad valorem property taxes levied and collected on all taxable property within the County.

Said appropriation is in addition to any appropriations provided for in the existing budget and tax levy. At said public hearing, all persons shall have the right to appear and be heard on the necessity of said appropriation.
