NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that sealed proposals are invited by the Marion Transit System (MTS), the municipal public transit system serving the City of Marion, IN, for providing an On-Board Video Surveillance System for MTS's fixed route and paratransit vehicles in strict conformance with the Contract Documents and Specifications therefor, entitled "On-Board Video Surveillance System" on file in the offices of the City of Marion Transit System (MTS) at 520 East 6th Street, Marion, IN 46953-2404. The Marion Transit System (MTS) operates under the direction of the Board of Public Works and Safety of the City of Marion, Indiana.

Each proposal must be contained in a sealed envelope stating "On-Board Video Surveillance System RFP", Attention: Jeff Edwards — Transit Manager" and filed at the offices of the Marion Board of Public Works and Safety, at 301 South Branson Street, Marion, Indiana 46952 or before 4:00 PM, EST, November 1, 2017.

Copies of the Contract Documents and Specifications may be obtained at the office of the City of Marion Transit System (MTS) at 520 East 6th Street, Marion, IN 46953-2404. Each proposal shall be submitted on a form prepared by the Marion Transit System (MTS). No proposal may be withdrawn for a period of sixty (60) days after opening. The Marion Transit System (MTS) will not reimburse bidders for costs incurred in the preparation of their proposals.

The successful bidder shall possess all applicable and valid license(s) at the time the contract is awarded. The Contract to be entered into pursuant to this Request for Proposals is subject to financial assistance from the Federal Transit Administration and the. Applicable federal and State of Indiana requirements will apply to this solicitation and procurement. If for any reason the afore-mentioned financial assistance is withdrawn, then the City of Marion, IN and the Transit System (MTS) may withdraw this "Request for Proposals" and/or terminate any Contract entered into in accordance with these Contract Documents and Specifications.

All bidders are required to read and completely familiarize themselves with the terms and conditions of the project's Contract Documents and Specifications, and to submit all necessary paperwork required of the bidder as specified in "Part I-Commercial Terms and Conditions" and "Part II-General Terms and Conditions."

The Marion Transit System (MTS) reserves the right to postpone proposal opening, accept or reject any and all bids and to waive any informality in any proposal, all as the MTS deems to be in its best interests and subject to the rules and regulations issued by the State of Indiana.
