Fifth Street Commons to open

It is in some ways a small convergence of a lot of things happening in Marion at the moment.

It was first proposed in the 20-year master plan for downtown Marion a decade ago.

It is the first fruit of the labor of a new Marion organization called Thriving Families, Thriving Grant County.

It is made possible by fund raising—\$54,000 at the local and state levels, including more than \$20,000 in local non-tax donations and a \$10,000 grant from the Community Foundation of Grant County.

Its initial use will be for the presentation of Shakespearean theater by Hoosier Shakes, a group affiliated with Indiana Wesleyan University.

It is both a place and an idea. It is the Fifth Street Commons, described in promotional literature as "a newly revitalized event space in downtown Marion," and as "a multipurpose outdoor space for the community."

The panoramic shot above shows the Fifth Street Commons area from the Adams Street side. Below is a conventional photograph of the area.

In its starkest terms it is two landscaped and paved areas carved from a half-block parking lot bounded by Fifth, Adams and Washington Streets just south of the Courthouse Square in Marion. One fronts onto Washington Street across from the reborn Boston Hill Center and the other, a mirror image, fronts onto Adams Street.

Common to both—and the source of the name—is Fifth Street, which runs east-west along the

Heat wave blankets area

While most people relish the summer months, many do not enjoy the sweltering heat that comes with it, and if the temperature creeps up too high, it can be downright dangerous.

Late last week, Marion, and most of northern Indiana, suffered through an excessive heat wave, with heat indices reaching as high as 110 degrees. Temperatures ranged between 90-95 degrees on Thursday, 93-97 degrees on Friday, and 91-96 degrees on

Saturday.

The extreme heat punctuated what has been a sizzling July in the city of the Marion. The average temperature has been 87.9 degrees, the highest on record since 2012 (89.5). Furthermore, as of July 18, the city's water usage was up to 4.1 million gallons per day, the most since July 2014, according to Marion Water Works.

Being out in those high temperatures for a prolonged period

July 25, 1917

south side of the property. Both feature benches, landscaped floral areas, seedling trees and a sense of being a place for casual gathering. Both have had lighting and electricity installed to make them more useful to the community in the evening. Both sites are open to all at no charge and can be reserved by contacting Janet Pearson, director of development services for the City of Marion.

Cathy Weatherspoon, executive director of the Thriving Families Thriving Grant County organization, said Monday that both locations have already had events booked in December. She

said the spaces will be available for church functions or services, dance performances, music presentations and other civic and theatrical activities.

Following a dedication program Wednesday evening, the commons became the venue for the second week of production for the 2019 edition of Hoosier Shakes, a Shakespearean summer theater program which this year is presenting “Othello” and “As You Like It.”

The theater troupe staged the plays last week at Matter Park and will present both plays this week, extending through Sunday at the Fifth Street Commons. Next week the venue will be Playacres Park in Fairmount.

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Trust in the Lord in order to eliminate worry

Psalm 37

One of the most difficult things we all must face is the issue of trust. It is not easy for any of us to trust others because we have all been betrayed at one time or another. When our trust in others is damaged, there are several things that can happen to us. We will only list one of them today, because it is our subject. When we don't trust, worry takes over. Do you have a problem with worry? Do you worry? If so, you have a problem.

Psalm 37 gives us great instruction in trusting the Lord. If we can't trust God, who can we trust? I would like to tell you that overcoming worry is an easy thing, but it's not. I am sure there are many of you reading this article who are guilty of worry. Did you know that worry is the absence of trust? Did you know that it is a sin to worry? If that be the case, let's do our best to look into God's Word and find a few solutions that might help us overcome worry and put trust into action.

There are several steps in Psalm 37 to help us prevent worry. The first step is found in the first two words of verse 1, "FRET NOT!" What God is saying is: don't worry. Why would we want to be bogged down in those things we have no control over? When it comes to the issues in life that we face, we must realize that we are not in control.

That brings us to the second step to prevent worry: We must learn to trust the Lord. Sounds like an easy thing to do, but it isn't all that simple. To put our trust in another involves a relationship. There are many people who belong to the Lord who don't have much of a relationship with Him because they only call

on Him when they need something. That sounds pretty harsh, and I guess it is, but it is the truth.

The third step of preventing worry is found in verse 2, where it tells us to do good. These are action words and there is a reason for that. I am sure that you have heard that idle hands are the devil's workshop (Proverbs 16:27). Our Lord doesn't want us to be idle followers. We should all be about the Father's business doing something. Many times I have plunged into helping others with the problems they are facing, and an amazing thing takes place: I forget about my own problems. Another thing that helps me when I help others is that I realize I really don't have any problems. If we would only be honest, we are all blessed. There is always someone else who has it a lot harder than we.

There are several other things we could share when it comes to worry and trust, but I leave you with one last thought, "Commit thy way unto the Lord" (verse 5). At Grace we always have a pastoral prayer during the worship service where people are invited to bring their problems to the Lord at the altar. The secret is

to bring it to the altar and leave it there. Don't pick your problems back up off the altar and take them with you. If you bring your problem to Him, leave it with Him.

I wish I could tell you what I have shared today is easy; however, it is not. If we want to be worry-free we must begin to take baby steps of trusting God. I promise you that the Scripture will never fail you.



of time can be detrimental to one's overall health, and can lead to heat exhaustion, heat stroke, and even death.

To combat the heat, Grant County Emergency Management, headed by interim director Bruce Bender, made sure to give the citizens of Marion time to prepare, using social media and the radio to pass on the information. Along with that, three cooling stations were established in Grant County to help people, particularly the homeless, find some relief. One was at the Fairmount Methodist Church, the second was at Brookhaven Wesleyan Church, and the third was at the Grant County Rescue Mission, located in downtown Marion.

For more than 30 years, the GCRM has served the homeless, the hungry, and the addicted members of the community. Throughout the year, they serve three meals a day, as well as shelter, to those in need.

In cases of extreme weather, the GCRM remains open for extended hours.

"It's absolutely important for our neighbors to escape the heat," LeeAnna Smith, director of development, said. "I know I was only outside when it was absolutely necessary--just walking back and forth to my car to get to work or go to the grocery store. For our homeless neighbors, they don't have that luxury. There is nowhere for them to escape the heat, and it's

have anywhere else to go."

Finally, on Sunday, the heat broke. Humidity dropped significantly, and while it was still warm, the temperature no longer posed a threat to anyone's well-being.

However, there is still a lot of summer left, and with it, there are sure to be plenty more uncomfortably hot days

And for those looking for a place to go, GCRM's doors are always open.

"We wanted people in Marion to know, and the greater Grant County area, that there is always a place for them to come here."

Pursuant to the laws of the Indiana General Assembly, notice is hereby given that the following described property is listed for sale for delinquent taxes and/or special assessments. The county auditor and county treasurer will apply on or after 08/30/2019 for a court judgment against the tracts or real property for an amount that is not less than the amount set out below and for an order to sell the tracts or real property at public auction to the highest bidder, subject to the right of redemption. Any defense to the application for judgment must be filed with the Grant County Superior 1 Court and served on the county auditor and treasurer before 08/30/2019. The court will set a date for a hearing at least seven (7) days before the advertised date of sale and the court will determine any defenses to the application for judgment at the hearing. The county auditor and the county treasurer are entitled to receive all pleadings, motions, petitions, and other filings related to the defense to the application for judgment.

Such sale will be held on 09/18/2019 at the County Complex, Council Chambers and that sale will continue until all tracts and real property have been offered for sale.

Property will not be sold for an amount which is less than the sum of:

(A) the delinquent taxes and special assessments on each tract or item of real property; and (B) the taxes and special assessments on the real property that are due and payable in the year of the sale, whether or not they are delinquent; and (C) all penalties due on the delinquencies, and (D) an amount prescribed by the county auditor that equals the sum of:

(1) thirty-five dollars (\$35) for postage and publication costs; and (2) any other costs incurred by the county that are directly attributable to the tax sale; and (E) any unpaid costs due under IC 6-1.1-24-2(c) from a prior tax sale.

No property listed below shall be sold if, at any time before the sale, the Total Amount for Judgment is paid in full. If the real property is sold in the tax sale, the amount required to redeem such property will be 110% of the minimum bid for which the tract or real property was offered at the time of sale, if redeemed not more than six (6) months after the date of sale, or 115% of the minimum bid for which the tract or real property was offered at the time of sale, if redeemed more than six (6) months after the date of sale, plus five percent (5%) per annum interest on the amount by which the purchase price exceeds the minimum bid on the real property plus five percent (5%) per annum interest on the amount by which the purchase price exceeds the minimum bid on the property. All taxes and special assessments upon the property paid by the purchaser subsequent to the sale, plus five percent (5%) per annum interest on those taxes and special assessments, will also be required to be paid to redeem such property.

In addition, IC 6-1.1-25-2 (e) states the total amount required

for redemption may include the following costs incurred and paid by the purchaser or the purchaser's assignee or the county before redemption: (1) The attorney's fees and cost of giving notice under IC 6-1.1-25-4.5; (2) The costs of title search or examining and update the abstract of title for the tract or item of real property. The period of redemption shall expire on Friday, September 18, 2020 for certificates sold in the tax sale. For certificates struck to the county, the period of redemption may expire Thursday, January 16, 2020.

If the tract or item of real property is sold for an amount more than the minimum bid and the property is not redeemed, the owner of record of the property who is divested of ownership at the time the tax deed is issued may have a right to the tax sale surplus.

The Auditor and Treasurer specifically reserve the right to withhold from the sale any parcel which has been listed in error, or which otherwise becomes ineligible for sale either prior to 09/18/2019 or during the duration of the sale.

This notice of real property tax sale, and the tax sale itself are undertaken and will be conducted pursuant to the requirements of the laws of the State of Indiana which regulate the sale of land for delinquent taxes, pursuant to I.C. 6-1.1-24-1 et seq.

The County does not warrant the accuracy of the street address or common description of the property, and a misstatement in the key number or street address does not invalidate an otherwise valid sale.

Minimum bid amounts are prescribed by law and are subject to change prior to the auction date. Pursuant to IC 6-1.1-24-3(e), property descriptions may be omitted for properties appearing on the certified list in consecutive years. Please arrive the morning of the tax sale at least 30 minutes before the beginning time to be assured you will receive your bid number before the start of the sale. Please bring your registration form and W9 form with you the morning of the tax sale. You will be able to print these forms from the registration web site.

Pursuant to IC 6-1.1-24-5.1 a business entity that seeks to register to bid at the Grant County Tax Sale must provide a certificate of good standing or proof of registration in accordance with IC 5-23 from the Secretary of State to the Grant County Treasurer.

Wright has returned to the area...and the Christmas parade

You may have heard his voice on the radio, seen his name in the newspaper, or perhaps even seen him in person. Whatever your source, the news has spread quickly that Steve Wright is back in town.

Not that he ever truly left. Even though the last six years of Wright's career with General Motors took him on a transcontinental journey, stretching from Spokane, Washington, to Toledo, Ohio, to Bristol, Connecticut, he maintained close ties to Marion.

Since Wright first stepped on the stage as a member of the 26th Street Singers, during his sophomore year at Marion High School in 1971, he has been in the community spotlight.

"If you knew Ritchie Walton, who founded and directed the swing choir, you would know how hard he worked students in the group. He wanted perfection, and he knew how to install that in all of us," Wright said. "I did six plays and eight musicals during my four years at Marion High School, and I really thought I would be a performer."

In a sense, that describes Wright's two distinct careers—one with Indiana Michigan Electric Co. and the other with GM. Both of those careers involved marketing, public relations and video productions, which kept him in the public eye.

Wright also served 12 years on the Marion City Council.

He has been involved with Marion's International Walkway of Lights since its inception and also helps coordinate Marion's annual Christmas Parade. Even when Wright was gone from Marion working as a GM dealer representative, he returned home annually to assist with both of those holiday events.

"My last assignments with GM gave me an opportunity to see the entire country—the West Coast, the Midwest and the East Coast—but there was never any doubt that Marion always would be home," Wright said.

"My wife Cindy and I met each other during my junior year at Marion High School, and we are still together, now with two kids and four grandkids. That is what brought us back to Marion. All of the kids are right here, and we can enjoy their lives. Life is good," he said.

And so in August 2018, Wright accepted an early buyout from GM, and he and Cindy moved back to Marion. They bought a home in Crane Pond, where they had lived before moving to Spokane six years ago.

Retirement hasn't gone quite as they had planned, though. In June, Wright was offered and accepted a job as director of development for the Marion campus of Ivy Tech Community College.

"I wasn't looking for a job, but I was aware of the key role Ivy Tech must play in the economic future of Grant County," Wright said. "There is a serious skilled-trades shortage, and Ivy Tech must fill that gap. I'm glad I got the job and look forward to doing whatever I can for at least a couple of years."

Although 2019 is a municipal election year, Wright has politely declined suggestions that he return to the local political arena. "I enjoyed my 12 years as a city councilman, but I am no longer interested in pursuing elective office," he said.

CHRISTMAS PARADE...AND LIGHTS

Marion will have two official grand openings for the 2019 Christmas season.

The International Walkway of Lights in Matter Park will open the Saturday before Thanksgiving, as it has done for several years. This year the opening date will be November 23.

Steve Wright, a Walkway of Lights board member, said the organization was reluctant to change the date because there would be no way to notify thousands of visitors who come from out of town.

There will two significant changes, though, for Marion's annual Christmas parade. The parade, which usually coincides with the walkway opening, will be held two weeks later, on December 7, and the parade will return to downtown Marion, where it was held for many years. In recent years, the parade has started on N. Washington St. and ended at Matter Park.

All of the events will be sponsored by Walkway of Lights, a not-for-profit organization established in 1991.

"In addition to the parade, an entire day of activities are being planned in the downtown area for December 7," Wright said. "We are also planning to decorate the downtown area to bring back the former Christmas City USA theme that began in the late 1960s."

There also will be a Christmas tree lighting ceremony on the northwest corner of the Courthouse lawn, where a large pine tree is located, Wright said.

"We're not sure exactly what the new decorations will look like, but we are working with GP Design and should have final plans by the end of August," Wright said.

He said the Walkway of Lights board would meet Thursday to choose a name for the downtown Christmas festival.

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Agent Orange and the Blue Water Navy Vets

The Department of Veterans Affairs is in the process of making decisions on claims for Navy veterans who served on vessels that were within 12 nautical miles seaward from the demarcation line in the waters of Vietnam and Cambodia during the Vietnam War, as defined in Public Law 116-23. These veterans are known as “Blue Water Navy Veterans.”

This is a big win for those veterans who were exposed to herbicides (such as Agent Orange). The January 29, 2019 court decision of Procopio vs Robert Wilkie, Secretary of Veteran Affairs, has made it possible for those veterans to seek healthcare and compensation due to the exposure. The bipartisan Blue Water Navy Vietnam Veterans Act gives the VA until January 1, 2020 to begin making decisions on related claims.

Blue Water Navy Veterans who have filed a claim in the past and were denied, or those Navy veterans who have not filed a claim because they were told they could not, who meet the requirement of serving on vessels that were within 12 nautical miles of Vietnam and have been diagnosed with one or more of the diseases associated with the exposure



to the herbicides should contact their local County Veteran Service Office to file the new claim or have their previously denied claim reopened based on this court case. Also, eligible survivors of deceased Blue Water Navy Veterans may benefit from the new law based on the veteran’s service. A list of Agent Orange presumptive conditions can be found on the va.gov website.

Like a typical 10-year-old, Trayce Bowman of Sweetser spent a week at camp this summer. This was his second year attending Camp John Warvel near North Webster, Indiana. This is a camp for kids 7-17 who are living with diabetes.

While “camperships” cover half the cost for each camper, family is still responsible for the other half. When Trayce heard the cost to attend camp he reached out to his mom Kaleena Alvarado, and grandma Donna Knight for help to raise the money needed.

What isn’t typical about Trayce is that he is already a seasoned fundraiser. Along with older brother Kameron, Trayce has assisted his grandma for five years with her fundraising efforts. As The Fudge Lady, with the boys by her side, Donna has set up at First Fridays and other community events



selling fudge and other sweet treats to raise funds for Grant County Cancer Services and the We Care Christmas for Kids.

So with mom crafting jewelry and grandma baking up goodies, Trayce went about raising the money he needed for camp, but he didn’t stop there. This year his goal was to raise enough money for himself, plus another camper.

Trayce met his goal. While his favorite part of

camp was the giant swing, Trayce was also able to meet Melissa Wilson from the Indiana Chapter of the American Diabetes Association and present her with an “envelope full of money” he had raised for the other camper.

When asked how he could raise so much money a few dollars at a time Trayce shares that he tells his customers his name, that he is raising money to attend camp and he finds

most of his customers—or donors—are very generous.

What’s next for this Oak Hill fifth grader? Described by his mom as one of “the little movers and shakers” of our community, he will continue to help grandma with her fundraising while building on his past success to raise even more “campership” money for next summer.

Varner takes GC Amateur, ties record

Approaching the 18th green at Meshingomesia Country Club on Sunday afternoon, Andrew Varner knew he was chasing history, but if the pressure of tying or breaking Jim Gallagher, Jr.'s 1981 Grant County Amateur record of 270 was weighing on his mind, he certainly did not show it.

Two putts later, surrounded by his family, friends, and fellow competitors, Varner capped off one of the most impressive two weekends of golf in the history of the tournament, winning the 88th Hoosier Jiffy Print Grant County Men's Amateur and tying Gallagher's all-time mark in the process.

Varner was in command from the first round at Walnut Creek, winning the event by 21 strokes and collecting his eighth amateur men's title. Only Boyd Toney (13) and recent Grant County Hall of Fame inductee Don Hulmes (11) have won more.

"He's worked so hard for it," his father, Bill said. "I'm just so proud of him. It's the best he has ever played in it. He's not even played that much this year, and it's just unbelievable to play this well."

Varner set the tone right from the start, beginning the tournament with a 67 (-5) at Walnut Creek, leading the next closest golfer, three-time winner Cody White, by six strokes. He widened his lead even more at Arbor Trace in the second round, shooting a 65 (-7) to take both a score of -12 and an 11-stroke advantage into the second weekend.

Playing at the Elks Country Club on Saturday--the course he grew up on--Varner continued his historic pace, finishing with eight birdies and just two bogies for a score of 66 (-6), and on Sunday Varner put the finishing touches on his masterpiece, finishing at even par at Meshingomesia to etch his place in Grant

County Amateur lore.

"I just avoided the big numbers," Varner said. "I didn't have a double bogey [on any] of the 72 holes. I made some putts, and I was just consistent, really. Nothing too flashy. You don't get to those scores and that low of a total very often, so it definitely feels good."

Former Eastbrook standout Lance Hoch finished as the runner-up for the third consecutive year, recording a score of 291, while White, a star in his own right at Oak Hill, finished third with a 293.

By his own admission, Varner does not play as much as he did in his younger years due to having a young family along with a full time job. Rather than playing hours and

hours a day, he focuses on a particular area for a shorter period of time, usually in the morning before he heads off to work.

Despite not having as much time to get out onto the golf course like some of his other colleagues, Varner was still able to put together

a masterful performance, one that will be remembered for years to come. Most importantly for Varner, he was able to do it in front of his wife Amanda, his two young sons, his parents, and his grandmother, who were there supporting him every round of the tournament.

"It's kind of like two stages of life," Varner said. "I had my earlier days, and now with the kids and stuff, it feels different. It feels better to win now, honestly."

In the 55th women's amateur, former Eastbrook Panther Jenna Boucher, one of the most decorated golfers in the program's history, won her second straight title, defeating state qualifier and Oak Hill junior Hope Mygrant, who was the only other participant.

"It really feels like quite the accomplishment for me," said Boucher.

Boucher began the tournament strong, shooting a 79 at Walnut Creek and a 76 at Arbor Trace. While she was not pleased with her performance at Elks, in which she shot +11 on the back nine en route to an 86, Boucher felt she played better at Meshingomesia, shooting an 85 to finish with a total score of 326.

"I definitely hit all my approach shots straighter than I did yesterday," Boucher

said. "Yesterday, it was all over the place."

Mygrant, playing in her first women's amateur, finished with a score of 347.

Boucher, coming off a tremendous high school career, is heading to Indiana Tech this coming fall, and is excited to be a part of an outstanding program. She has spent a lot of time perfecting her game over the course of the summer, participating in several IGA tournaments, along with the Indiana Amateur Golf Tournament, in order to prepare for her first collegiate season.

"Right now, the Indiana Tech team is really good," Boucher said. "I'm just really hoping to make the traveling team. That's what I'm looking forward to."

In the men's first flight, Mike Hicks took home first place honors with a score of 311. He shot a 73 at Elks, which tied Hoch and White for the second best score of the day. Jared Jarck placed second with 313, while The Sports Herald Senior and Junior Amateur winners, Tony Smith and Ty Corey, tied for third with 316.

Eastbrook assistant basketball coach Josh Dakin won the second flight with a final score of 323, while his brother, Justin, was second with 340. Brian Cowgill placed third with 344.

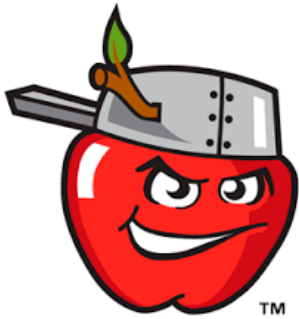
So I came up with the number of 500, an average of 10 per year. Some years more and some years less.

And then it happened. Fort Wayne's number nine hitter jacked one out of the park—a grand slam!—to make it 11-11. The stadium was rocking.

A bunt single, and a base hit to left put runners at the corners, with the go-ahead run at third base.

Here is where some smart managing won the game.

With two strikes on the batter, the runner on third broke for home, then stopped and got caught in a rundown. Seeing his teammate in a pickle, the runner from first broke for second, and, for some unknown reason—there were two outs!—somehow, someway (remember, this is minor
