## Vermilion will replace Mahan

When Ann Vermilion was chosen Tuesday night to complete the term of State Rep. Kevin Mahan, she became the first Grant County resident in more than a decade to serve in the Indiana General Assembly.

Vermilion was chosen by Republican District 31 precinct committee persons to succeed Mahan, a Hartford City resident, who resigned to take a job with an Indianapolis-based health care company. His resignation was effective July 31.

Vermilion received 36 of the 49 votes that were cast during the first ballot of the caucus at the Marion campus of Ivy Tech Community College. Steve Henderson, a Marion City Councilman, received 10 votes, and John Lancaster, a Blackford County Commissioner, received 3 votes.

Mahan endorsed Vermilion as his successor in a WBAT radio interview a week ago. Mahan's term will end in November 2020, and Vermilion said she would seek a new two-year term in next year's elections.

Marion businessman Tim Harris, who served in the legislature from 2004 to 2008, was the last state legislator who lived in Grant County.

Vermilion said the opportunity to have a Grant County resident serving in the legislature was a factor in her decision to seek the District 31 seat. "I think it is a special time to once again have a hometown, home-grown, home-educated representative in the General Assembly," she said.

Vermilion and her husband Aaron, who is a pharmaceutical executive, are Marion natives and

## City plans downtown event for National Night Out

For the first time since the early 2000s, Marion's Neighborhood Associations are working together to celebrate National Night Out by hosting a citywide event at the recently opened Fifth Street Commons in downtown Marion.

Unlike previous observances when individual neighborhoods were encouraged to arrange their own activities, this year's event will draw all neighborhood associations to a common area. National Night Out will be August 6, from 6-9 pm.

Kayla Johnson, Marion Neighborhood Association director, said that hosting an annual campaign

celebrating the collaborative work being done to build and maintain Marion neighborhoods is important. "Without trusting relationships between neighbors, first responders and city officials our neighborhoods suffer," she said.

Food trucks and concession stands will open at 5 pm, and several motorcycle clubs will do a drive-through at 5:45 pm, followed by the National Anthem at 6 pm. The evening also will feature music by Glen Welch and a sneak-preview performance by the Marion Civic Theater.

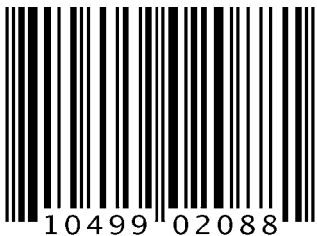

### August 1, 1920

Former Indiana Governor J. Frank Hanly was killed in a car-train accident near Dennison, Ohio. He had served as Governor from 1905- 1909.

### August 2, 2002

The Indiana State Quarter was released by the U.S. Mint. Part of the 50-State Quarter series, the coin features an image of a racecar superimposed on an outline of the state with the inscription "Crossroads of America." Also included are 19 stars, signifying Indiana as the 19th state to join the Union.



### August 3, 1795

The Treaty of Greenville was signed by Native Americans from a dozen different tribes. It established a border between Indian territory and land controlled by the United States.

### August 4, 1823

Oliver Morton was born in Wayne County. The first Indiana governor to be born in the Hoosier State, he was chief executive during the Civil War and later served as United States Senator.

### August 5, 1882

James Whitcomb Riley's poem When the Frost is on the Pumpkin was published, becoming one of his most popular works.

### August 6, 1802

William Conner established a trading post on the White River near what would become the city of Indianapolis.

### August 7, 1908

The Fisher and Bradshaw Company of Delphi, Indiana, built the first school bus. Called a "school hack," it was a closed-body horse-drawn wagon.

graduates of Marion High School: Aaron in 1989 and Ann in 1992. Two of their children, Ella, 17, and Beck, 14, are students in the Marion schools. A third child, Samuel 20, is a Marion graduate, now attending Indiana University-Bloomington.

Ann Vermilion earned a bachelor's degree in management from IU-Bloomington and a master of business administration degree from IU-Kokomo. She has worked as a management consultant, primarily in the health-care industry, and was a senior administrator at Marion General Hospital for 15 years.

In the early 2000s, Vermilion worked as the marketing development director for Gannett-owned newspapers in Marion, Muncie and Richmond.

But, Vermilion said, it was her work in the health-care profession that initially started her thinking about the possible impact she could have as a state legislator.

"When you are in health care, you are working hand in hand with legislators because it is an area that most legislators don't fully understand," she said. "Over the past 15 years, legislators have called me frequently to ask what I think about a specific bill and how it might impact Grant County and/or Marion General Hospital.

"So I truly appreciate the relationship that people in my profession have with legislators. And that has not been just statewide, but it has reached all the way down to Washington, DC."

Vermilion has served on the Governor's Task Force and the Attorney General's Bitter Pill Initiative, both dealing with heroin and opioid abuse. In January, she attended President Donald Trump's State of the Union Address as the one invited guest of Fifth District Congresswoman Susan Brooks.

Vermilion has served on multiple local organizations, most of them dealing with economic development and health care. The two are closely related, she said.

"It is heartbreaking when we can't get a company to locate in Grant County because our health-related determinants are so bad," Vermilion said. "We rank 90th out of 92 Indiana counties when it comes to the vitality of our health. I am hugely passionate about trying to address this issue."

Vermilion's Christian faith, she said, is the most important factor in her life, and it also is a major concern as she heads for the Indiana General Assembly.

"I fully expect that my faith will be tested in ways it has never been tested before," she said. "I just have to put my faith in God. He opened this door for me, and I trust that he will protect me as I walk through it."

Everything that I have is a gift from God

Do you ever stop and think about all that you have? If we would just stop for a moment and think, we are really blessed. We have a roof over our head, food on the table, clothes on our backs and family and friends who love us. Contentment is an acquired trait. Why spend all of your time complaining about what you don't have? Most people live their entire lives missing out on the joys of life and what they have. For many folks, complaining becomes a way of life. Life was made to enjoy and have peace.

We read in the book of James that life is a vapor, here today and gone tomorrow. What I need to do is realize I have 24 hours a day, seven days a week. I want to be able to make the most of every remaining day that I have left. Take a few moments every day to pray and give thanks to God for what you have. I have more than I ever dreamed of having in life, and I am very thankful. I realize that everything I have is a gift from God, and it all still belongs to Him. I

am only a "steward" of His possessions. The next time you want to complain about what you don't have, stop, think, and take inventory. We are all blessed and have much to be thankful for. Get up tomorrow with the attitude that you are going to play on the strings that you have and never give a second thought about the missing ones. I leave you today with a poem:

Pursuant to the laws of the Indiana General Assembly, notice is hereby given that the following described property is listed for sale for delinquent taxes and/or special assessments. The county auditor and county treasurer will apply on or after 08/30/2019 for a court judgment against the tracts or real property for an amount that is not less than the amount set out below and for an order to sell the tracts or real property at public auction to the highest bidder, subject to the right of redemption. Any defense to the application for judgment must be filed with the Grant County Superior 1 Court and served on the county auditor and treasurer before 08/30/2019. The court will set a date for a hearing at least seven (7) days before the advertised date of sale and the court will determine any defenses to the application for judgment at the hearing. The county auditor and the county treasurer are entitled to receive all pleadings, motions, petitions, and other filings related to the defense to the application for judgment.

Such sale will be held on 09/18/2019 at the County Complex, Council Chambers and that sale will continue until all tracts and real property have been offered for sale.

Property will not be sold for an amount which is less than the sum of:

(A) the delinquent taxes and special assessments on each tract or item of real property; and (B) the taxes and special assessments on the real property that are due and payable in the year of the sale, whether or not they are delinquent; and (C) all penalties due on the delinquencies, and (D) an amount prescribed by the county auditor that equals the sum of:

(1) thirty-five dollars (\$35) for postage and publication costs; and (2) any other costs incurred by the county that are directly attributable to the tax sale; and (E) any unpaid costs due under IC 6-1.1-24-2(c) from a prior tax sale.

No property listed below shall be sold if, at any time before the sale, the Total Amount for Judgment is paid in full. If the real property is sold in the tax sale, the amount required to redeem such property will be 110% of the minimum bid for which the tract or real property was offered at the time of sale, if redeemed not more than six (6) months after the date of sale, or 115% of the minimum bid for which the tract or real property was offered at the time of sale, if redeemed more than six (6) months after the date of sale, plus five percent (5%) per annum interest on the amount by which the purchase price exceeds the minimum bid on the real property plus five percent (5%) per annum interest on the amount by which the purchase price exceeds the minimum bid on the property. All taxes and special assessments upon the property paid by the purchaser subsequent to the sale, plus five percent (5%) per annum interest on those taxes and special assessments, will also be required to be paid to redeem such property.

In addition, IC 6-1.1-25-2 (e) states the total amount required

for redemption may include the following costs incurred and paid by the purchaser or the purchaser's assignee or the county before redemption: (1) The attorney's fees and cost of giving notice under IC 6-1.1-25-4.5; (2) The costs of title search or examining and update the abstract of title for the tract or item of real property. The period of redemption shall expire on Friday, September 18, 2020 for certificates sold in the tax sale. For certificates struck to the county, the period of redemption may expire Thursday, January 16, 2020.

If the tract or item of real property is sold for an amount more than the minimum bid and the property is not redeemed, the owner of record of the property who is divested of ownership at the time the tax deed is issued may have a right to the tax sale surplus.

The Auditor and Treasurer specifically reserve the right to withhold from the sale any parcel which has been listed in error, or which otherwise becomes ineligible for sale either prior to 09/18/2019 or during the duration of the sale.

This notice of real property tax sale, and the tax sale itself are undertaken and will be conducted pursuant to the requirements of the laws of the State of Indiana which regulate the sale of land for delinquent taxes, pursuant to I.C. 6-1.1-24-1 et seq.

The County does not warrant the accuracy of the street address or common description of the property, and a misstatement in the key number or street address does not invalidate an otherwise valid sale.

Minimum bid amounts are prescribed by law and are subject to change prior to the auction date.

This registration is good for all counties that SRI services. You need to register only once for all counties. Make sure to bring the completed form with you to each sale. This will speed up the registration process for you the morning of the sale. If you do not have access to a computer with internet service you may register the morning of the sale.

Please arrive the morning of the tax sale at least 30 minutes before the beginning time to be assured you will receive your bid number before the start of the sale. If you do not have access to a computer with internet service you may register the morning of the sale.

Please bring your registration form and W9 form with you the morning of the tax sale. You will be able to print these forms from the registration web site.

Pursuant to IC 6-1.1-24-5.1 a business entity that seeks to register to bid at the Grant County Tax Sale must provide a certificate of good standing or proof of registration in accordance with IC 5-23 from the Secretary of State to the Grant County Treasurer.

# It's been three decades since two great stories debuted

We didn't know it at the time, but 30 years ago this past winter and spring--February and May, to be exact--we guys were given two of the great "guy" moments of our time or any other time.

First, the harsh reality: 30 years, three decades, since "Field of Dreams" became a movie, since we learned that...if we build it he will come, since we learned no, this isn't heaven, it's Iowa, since we were introduced to Moonlight Graham and Ray Kinsella and Terence Mann, who of course we all knew at the time was really J.D. Salinger carefully disguised as James Earl Jones.

And 30 years--those same three lost decades in which we may or may not have done very much with our own lives--30 years since "Lonesome Dove," since Augustus McCrae--"Gus" and Woodrow F. Call headed north on the Hat Creek Cattle Company drive from Texas to Montana.

You know the stories, both of them, and if you don't there's neither time nor space here to tell them adequately. Suffice it to say that both are tales of seekers, searchers, men mostly in search of either who they are, who they were, or more importantly, who and what they might become in whatever time if left is left to them.

"Field of Dreams" is simply a baseball movie until it becomes so much more. "Lonesome Dove" is simply a western movie until it becomes so much more.

"Lonesome Dove" actually was a TV show, a mini-series back before Netflix, before we knew what binge watching was. It ran from Sunday through Wednesday, February 5-8, 1989. By the end of that week Gus and Woodrow and Jake Spoon and Lorena Wood and the persistently evil Blue Duck had become part of the American story, if Larry McMurtry's great novel of four years earlier hadn't already put them there. Robert Duvall and Tommy Lee Jones became forever "Gus" and "Woodrow."

Much of the same with "Field of Dreams." W.P. Kinsella, a Canadian writer who spent a lot of time hanging around the haunts of the University of Iowa, published "Shoeless Joe" back in 1982. Literary types called it a "magic realist novel," a book about a real guys like big league baseball player Joe Jackson--he of the Black Sox scandal of 1919--and an obscure ball player named Archibald Graham, who played one game in the major leagues in 1905. Nicknamed

Kevin Costner, who starred in the movie "Field of Dreams."

"Moonlight," he went on to become a medical doctor in a small Minnesota town. The "magic" part, of course, is what makes the movie magic. You either believe or you don't.

It's all about guys and their fathers and baseball and it's very complicated. Just like "Lonesome Dove" doesn't have very much to do with cattle.

But you know all this. What you might not know is that the original title for Kinsella's book was "The Kidnapping of J.D. Salinger," which makes sense

only if you recall how Terence Mann got from his Boston apartment to an Iowa cornfield, a field just outside of Dyersville, Iowa, to which many of us have made a pilgrimage and trotted around the bases.

Lonesome Dove began life as a much shorter story by Larry McMurtry titled "Streets of Laredo," which sat on the shelf for 15 years. McMurtry and movie maker Peter Bogdonavich originally intended for John Wayne to play Woodrow, Jimmy Stewart as Gus and Henry Fonda as Jake Spoon.

As so often happens in the Hollywood world, it never happened.

So, a dozen years later writer McMurtry is driving along some street in Texas, where he has always lived, sees an old bus with "Lonesome Dove Baptist Church" painted on the side, goes home immediately and begins the job of rewriting all that Laredo stuff from 15 years earlier.

He builds around a couple of real-life characters named Charles Goodnight and Oliver Loving, who had, in fact, done something much like Gus and Woodrow were about to do. The book, the novel "Lonesome Dove," won the Pulitzer Prize for fiction in 1986.

In the original casting, Robert Duvall was to play Woodrow, but Duvall wisely declined and opted for the Gus part. In another irony, James Garner had originally agreed to play Woodrow. That changed; Garner was then 60 years old and Jones was 41.

In one little intersection between two great movie moments, remember how I said Jimmy Stewart was the original actor looked at to play Gus? The very same Jimmy Stewart was the first pick to play Doc Graham in "Field of Dreams." He declined and Burt Lancaster stepped in.

We aren't in the movie review business here, but if you haven't seen 'em, "Lonesome Dove" and "Field of Dreams," go get them and watch them. If you have seen them, watch them again. You forget a lot over 30 years.

## Giants host grid scrimmage; go 2-0-1

With the start of the 2019 football season less than a month away, the Marion Giants hosted a four-team scrimmage at Dick Lootens Stadium last Tuesday evening, giving the community a glimpse of what they can expect in the upcoming football campaign.

Indianapolis Crispus Attucks, Cascade, and Phalen, a relatively new charter school, also participated in the scrimmage.

The event, which lasted just over an hour and a half, featured three 30-minute sessions, as each team took turns competing against one another. The coaches were on hand as well, providing tips for improvement and giving praise when big plays were made.

The Giants, overall, performed well, finishing 2-0-1 on the evening. Marion's starters opened the night with a 21-7 triumph over Attucks, before scoring two late touchdowns in a 14-7 victory over Cascade. In the final session, the Giants' backups and JV players played Phalen to a 7-7 tie.

Heading into the season, the biggest question for the Giants is how the defense will perform. Dre Aguilar, Anthony Reynolds, Brayden Burke, Xavier Gee, and Christian Ross, to name a few, helped spearhead one of the top defenses in Indiana in 2018. Now, they are all gone, leaving question marks at key positions.

After Tuesday's performance, Marion Head Coach Craig Chambers came away encouraged. In their two games, the Giants' starters allowed just five first downs and two touchdowns, showing the tenacity and the athleticism that they flashed all last season.

"We are really excited about the defense," Chambers said. "We've got some new guys stepping up, [and] they are playing pretty well. We are getting in film sessions and teaching them, so they are learning a lot. We are just trying to maintain and hold on, and hopefully by mid-"

# Grant County volleyball County teams are preparing for season



### Eastbrook

In 2018, the Eastbrook Panthers collected 13 wins and improved in nearly every area. They increased their win total by six from the previous season and continued to move the program in the right direction, but the team will have a much different look in 2019, starting at the very top.

After serving as an assistant coach last year, and after coaching for two years at the Grant County Volleyball Club, Bailie Havens takes the reigns of the Eastbrook volleyball program, looking to build on the foundation that former coach Kelly Rupert left behind.

“My goal is, first of all, to give them a little sense of stability. They’ve had a couple of coaches over the last few years,” Havens said. “I also want to help build the program a little bit further. I want to get the youth involved, and I want to get more kids coming out and wanting to be involved in volleyball. Right now, we have a small group, and I really want that to grow.”

Rupert informed Havens in the middle of the 2018 season that she would not be back for a third season, and thought that Havens would be the right coach for the job. After talking with former Eastbrook AD Brad Yordy, she was approved.

Right from the time she was hired, Havens has immersed herself with the group, fostering relationships and building rapport with her players before the season begins. “I like structure, obviously, but I like to have fun, too,” Havens said. “I like to have a good relationship with the girls, and I want them to enjoy their time.”

Throughout the offseason, Havens and the Panthers have gone back to the drawing board focusing on fundamentals and team-building exercises. Even though the Panthers will be a young group—with only three returners from a year ago—Havens is pleased with the progress they have made throughout the summer.

“We’ve had probably about 16 girls coming to open gyms, and they are also doing the weight program,” Havens said. “They are honestly doing pretty well. I’ve been impressed with who has shown up and how everybody has worked so hard.

“They are such a coachable group. They’re putting the work in. They listen, and they are doing the best that they can to progress to get ready for the season.”

Lexi Binker, Ava Walter, and Brianna Stepp are the only three returning varsity players from a season ago, but they will have plenty of reinforcements in 2019. Seniors Elizabeth Stallsmith and Alli Hyatt, both first year volleyball players, together with Allannah Brenner, who played JV last year, will look to provide leadership and guidance, while Eastbrook’s young talent, including Chloe Poe, Blessing Geisler, Allyson Hiles, and Kayleigh Gross will look to carve out roles for themselves on the varsity roster.

“We’ve got a bunch of young girls,” Havens said. “We have a lot of freshmen [and sophomores] coming in. We are really young. But even the upperclassmen have stuck in there. They are leading them along the way...and they’re into it. They’re ready to go.”

Heading into her first year at the helm, Havens has two main objectives.

First, she wants her players to love the game while continuously growing and developing throughout the season, and, secondly, she wants to drive the Eastbrook volleyball program forward, keeping it on the pathway towards success.

“I want them to enjoy volleyball,” Havens concluded. “I want them to look at it as something that they are looking forward to. Even if we don’t win every single game, I want them to continue to play. I want the program to be stable.

“I definitely have a lot to learn, that’s for sure, [but] I just want to set a good example. I want them to feel like I am there because I care for them. I want to be there, and I want them to look at me and think, ‘You know what? She actually does want to coach, and she wants to help us out.’ That is my goal.”



### Madison-Grant

After a tremendous high school coaching career, Robert Holloway stepped down as the varsity head coach after the 2018 season. His replacement, however, is someone who is not only familiar with the Madison-Grant program, but who is also part of the Holloway coaching tree.

After 11 years as the assistant coach, Kayla Jump takes the reigns of the Argyll

volleyball program, looking to keep M-G’s winning tradition intact. Jump learned quite a bit from watching her father coach and played an integral part in helping him build the volleyball program into what it is today. Now, she is looking forward to carrying on her father’s legacy.

“We’ve really developed our club program at school,” Jump said. “We are really interactive with a lot of different programs, not just volleyball. I love our girls. I love our kids that come to the program. I know about things in the past, and I know a lot about where we want to get in the future.

“I just want to make our school proud, make our girls proud, and make my dad proud. I want to keep building our program. It’s not just about one year, it’s about growth every year.”

Madison-Grant has been successful for many years, but the 2018 season was a bit out of character for an Argyll volleyball team.

The group had issues with consistency all season long, playing well one minute and struggling mightily the next.

Jump is hoping to reverse that trend in 2019 and has spent much of the offseason working on strengthening the team’s conditioning in an effort to increase the team’s consistency on the court.

“That was something that we really wanted to change,” Jump said. “Hitting the weights [and] doing a lot of core exercises to get us more physically active to where we need to be. As we move through the summer and the season, we are trying to get [into] better physical shape than what we have been.

“Our thing is to get physically more fit, because right now we have a lot of kids trying hard, but physically, we are behind.”

Many of the girls have taken their training seriously, playing club volleyball throughout the summer months. Along with working on the physical skills, Jump has stressed the importance of the mental side of the game of volleyball.

She has been pleased with progress in both areas.

“This spring, we talked a lot about the [mental aspect,]” Jump said. “We’ve done a lot of thinking [about] why we are doing things and how we are doing things and breaking techniques down. We do drills, but mentally, we are trying to keep up to speed to compete.”

On paper, the Argylls return a strong group of players, and the sophomore class, according to Jump, is particularly talented.

“We don’t have that stud—we have three or four girls that can put a ball down,” Jump said. “They’ve really grown in the past six months.”

One of those sophomores is Grace Holmberg. An intense, high-energy player, Holmberg has impressed coaches with her work ethic and her tenacity throughout the summer. “She is everywhere,” Jump said. “She can be a passer. She wants to block. # Eastbrook holds basketball camp

It might be summer, but the work never stops for Grant County student athletes and their coaches. Heading into his second year at the helm of the Eastbrook boys basketball program, Greg Allison continues to build and develop it, holding his second annual K-8 basketball camp over the course of this past week.

"I think it's important," Allison said. "It's important to have this. The fundamentals, the skills, it's important at a younger age. You start teaching that so that way they can become more advanced by the time they get to junior high and high school."

All in all, 55-60 kids participated in the week-long camp, according to Allison, working on a variety of skill sets, depending on their age group.

The camp was broken down into three different segments, with the first group featuring students in grades six through eight. Being older and more advanced, the kids took part in a number of drills focusing on one specific area of basketball. From layups and post moves to catching-and-shooting and zig-zag dribbling exercises, Allison and his coaching staff made sure that all camp participants were gaining experience and improving in each area.

With Allison now heading into his second season, many of these players, particularly the eighth graders have been in his system for an entire calendar year. They know what Allison expects,

and they know the kind of program that he is looking to build at Eastbrook High School.

Their dedication to honing their craft has not gone unnoticed. From last year's camp to now, and even from Monday to Friday, Allison has been pleased with the strides that the kids have made.

"We are seeing progress," Allison said. "It's amazing how kids [have] progressed, even from Monday. This is our second year, and we are seeing really good progress

for sure."

The second session was the youngest group, featuring kids from kindergarten to second grade, while the third and final phase was for students in grades three through five. These groups focused more on the basics, particularly ball handling, dribbling, and proper shooting form.

"We are just trying to introduce them to the game a little bit, as well as teaching them fundamentals on top of it," Allison said. "Especially

with the younger ages, you want them to have a good time."

By working to develop Eastbrook's next generation of basketball players, Allison's main goal and objective is abundantly clear. He is not looking to build a great basketball team in the next few years. Rather, he is looking to build a culture, one that will be successful, and fruitful, for many more years to come.

After all, Allison does not have to look far to find a pro-

gram that he can mold his after. Eastbrook Head Football Coach Jeff Adamson, heading into his 31st year, was a young man when he took over the program back in 1988. Over of the course of the last three decades, Adamson has built the program into a powerhouse, winning 268 games and three semi-state championships in the process.

The old saying goes that "Rome was not built in a day." Adamson's football program did not become

successful overnight, and Allison knows that his basketball program will also need time to cultivate. However, there is no doubt that it is heading in the right direction.

"As long as we are improving year after year, that's kind of where we are at," Allison said. "We've taken that same type of model—working with the younger kids, opening up the gym, and giving them opportunities to come in and improve. We are very encouraged."

Before the girl's basketball team won its first state championship, and before the softball team completed its best season in school history, the Oak Hill Golden Eagles volleyball team put together a successful campaign of its own.

Under first-year head coach Kristi Carmichael, and behind the strong play of Khloe Price, Kinsey Price, Ashlyn Transier, Taylor Westgate, and a host of others, the Golden Eagles thrived in 2018, winning 22 matches and showcasing a high level of improvement

as the season progressed.

While Oak Hill did lose a talented senior group, but they have another one looking to make their mark. Taylor Westgate, Ella Ridgeway, Alyssa Carmichael, Abby Shaw, and Coleena Selleck will be relied upon heavily in 2019, and Carmi-

chael believes they are up for the challenge.

"I can see all five of our seniors having a big year," Carmichael said. "Ella [Ridgeway] works really well with Taylor [Westgate], so they are in sync with each other. My daughter, Alyssa, she played club this summer and got a lot better. She and Abby Shaw will most likely play left side...and [potentially] have great years. And Coleena Selleck, she's a fighter and she's a great passer."

Junior Julianne Gosnell and sophomores Mia Edwards and Alyssa Thompson look to take on bigger roles. Furthermore, the Golden Eagles have a talented group of 10 freshmen who, according to Carmichael, will play on the JV and be called upon when necessary.

With a strong group of players returning, a host of young talent waiting in the wings, and a head coach heading into her second year with much more confidence, the Golden Eagles look to be a successful volleyball team once again in 2019.

"They are a talented group," Carmichael concluded. "I'm excited."
