## Gas City/Mississinewa plan auditorium

When the "new" Mississinewa High School was built nearly 40 years ago in Gas City, what money was available was not enough to pay for an auditorium in the building. Thus, Mississinewa High School has been the only one of five public high schools in the county without a large assembly area.

## Experiencing politics, both locally and nationally Trump rally was a phenomenon : Caucus was politics at the retail level

One of the dictionary definitions for "phenomenon" is: "an exceptional, unusual, or abnormal person, thing, or occurrence."

By the above definition, the Donald Trump rally in U.S. Bank Arena in Cincinnati, OH, last Thursday night was definitely phenomenal. It set a record for the largest attendance ever in that venue with more than 18,000 people inside, and many more outside whose tickets couldn't get them in because of safety concerns. The four hours I spent there were filled with interesting happenings that had me wondering, "What's going to happen next?"

I arrived in Cincinnati at 4:15 for the 7 pm event and parked a few blocks from the arena for

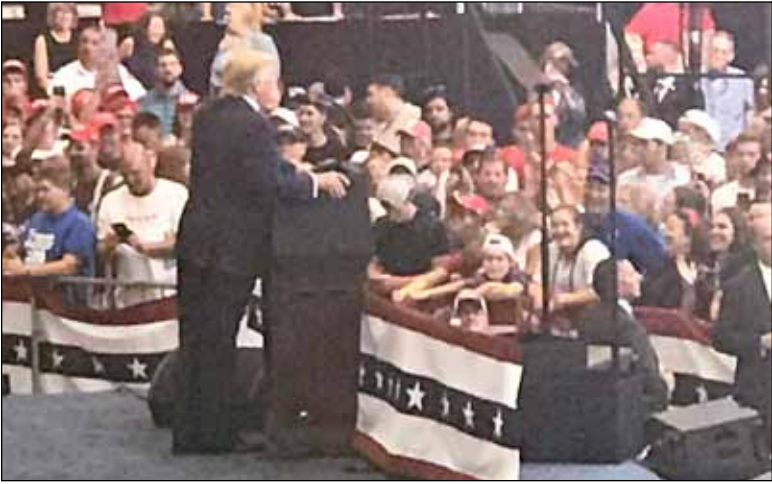

Seeking an insight into how American politics works at its most basic, grassroots, retail level?

No need to tromp off to a Trump

rally. All you need do is visit the party caucus of your choice next time there's an elective office vacated by death, relocation, resignation, any reason that causes a gathering of precinct committeemen to select a successor.

They happen with some frequency, although often without much fanfare. An exception was last week's gathering of the Republican faithful to pick a successor to Kevin Mahan as state representative from District 31 to the Indiana House of Representatives, one of 100 people—men, women, Republicans, Democrats—chosen by six million Hoosiers to share the burden of making the laws.

Mahan, a Blackford County resident, held the office for nearly a decade, but chose to relocate to suburban Indianapolis and take

## Board chair takes over as president of Taylor U

The Taylor University board of trustees appointed its chair Paige Comstock Cunningham as interim president of the school, effective August 15 succeeding outgoing President Lowell Haines, who resigned in June.

Cunningham is expected to serve at least through the coming academic year during a formal national search for the next president. The board will announce the timetable for a national search later. Cunningham has indicated that she does not wish to be a candidate for the permanent position.



Cunningham has served as a Taylor trustee for 17 years, and is the executive director of The Center for Bioethics & Human Dignity and an affiliate professor at Trinity Law

School and Trinity Graduate School. She graduated from Taylor University (summa cum laude) and earned her J.D. from Northwestern University Law School, Master of Bioethics (summa cum laude) from Trinity International University and Ph.D. (Educational Studies) from Trinity Evangelical Divinity School.

"I have a deep love and respect for Taylor University and am humbled by the honor of being selected by my peers to lead this great institution and academic community as interim president," said Cunningham.

of merchandise with both pro-Trump and anti-Trump messages of various tastes and class. There were also a number of street preachers wearing portable sound systems and large banners.

Thanks to the journalistic legitimacy of The News Herald I was afforded the opportunity to secure press credentials and allowed to bypass the thousands of folks standing in line and enter the media entrance to the arena. The difficulty came in trying to find the media entrance, and, after locating it and approaching it, being redirected around the entire arena because the sidewalk was closed. It seems the 100 feet or so I had left to reach the entrance crossed the path where the President would enter two hours later. So I was directed to circle the arena and approach from the other side.

After a rigorous security check of my person, my briefcase, and my computer and iPhone, I was admitted to the media area on the floor of the arena. The time was 5 pm for the scheduled 7 pm start, and before I could find a seat I heard the strains of the national anthem. This was followed by the pledge of allegiance and then an invocation. Following those, I discovered that all the seats allotted for media were taken. At three other Trump rallies in past years, I had never experienced this.

So I put my media credential in my pocket and left the media area looking for something to eat. The concourse was beginning to fill with people who had arrived early and were overwhelming the concession stands. The wait for food was more than 45 minutes. I decided not to stand in line that long, so I headed in and found a seat in the lower part of the arena, 12 rows from the floor and to the left of the speaker's dais. It offered a good view of the walkway to the stage.

As I moved through the crowd I took the opportunity to observe the folks who were in attendance. I was surprised by how many younger people were there, including a number of school-aged children and families. The majority displayed hats or shirts with slogans like "Make America Great Again" or "Trump 2020." The crowd was friendly, happy, and in an anticipatory mood, more like awaiting a concert performer than a political candidate.

At 5:20, Donald Trump, Jr., came out and spoke for about 25 minutes, warming up the crowd. When he was done, he walked along the barricades signing hats, shirts, programs and signs, and taking selfies with folks for another 25 minutes. Next came 30 minutes of very loud music, includ-

ing the songs, "My Way" and "Rocket Man." The crowd did the wave.

About 10 minutes before the announced start time, a security detail of 10 men in black suits walked back and forth along the walkway leading to the stage and closely inspected the dais. Nine pool photographers were allowed into the secure area around the raised walkway and they spread out on both sides of it. "We Are the Champions" and "Eye of the Tiger" were interspersed with more high-brow instrumental selections.

At 7, the TV lighting was increased. Above and to the left of the dais a group of about 20 African-Americans stood and cheered, displaying white T-shirts with large black lettering declaring, "TRUMP & Republicans Are Not RACISTS." It made for the most interesting photo of the evening, and prompted cynics and critics to suggest they were paid to be there. If they were actors they were very good and spent the next two hours engaging in their task with an enthusiasm that I thought was more than hired help would produce. Draw your own conclusion.

At 7:12 the emcee introduced Vice President Mike Pence, who spent 15 minutes in a review of the significant accomplishments of the current administration. It sounded like a preview of his own 2024 Presidential campaign and maybe it was. He was interrupted by chants from the crowd of "Four More Years," "Build That Wall," and "U.S.A."

Finally, at 7:30 pm, Pence introduced President Donald Trump, who took five minutes to walk across the raised walkway to the dais. He paused occasionally to wave at the crowd. At 5:34 he began a standard, 75-minute Donald Trump campaign speech. He was careful to recognize GOP night in Cincinnati.

dignitaries in attendance, including Ohio Governor Rob Portmann, Senator Mike DeWine, and other local folks. About 45 minutes into his speech a few people left—that continued and increased until he finished.

The speech covered all his familiar themes: coal and energy production, foreign trade deals (both TPP and MCA), tariffs, immigration and sanctuary cities, abortion and pro-life issues, health care and VA choice, the space race, and others. It is designed to delight the crowd, which it does. He is interrupted by a protester, a medical emergency, and again by a protestor who has to be carried out on a fire department stretcher. I got the impression that the first one might have been staged, because it has happened in a similar fashion at the other Trump rallies I've attended. Again, draw your own conclusion.

Finally, the 2020 election was mentioned. "This election is about you," he declared, and, recognizing his cue, the security detail began to move carefully around to the exit side of the dais. President Trump finished with references to the second amendment, pro-life again, law enforcement, and jobs. He was preaching to the choir, and he knew it. He finished his speech to rousing applause and exited the arena slowly as he basked in the adoration of his supporters. I got a sense that he really enjoys these rallies and his energy remained at a high level throughout the night. He didn't seem to be 77 years old, which he is.

Whether you think Donald Trump is the best or worst President, there is no disputing that he is a cultural phenomenon. He is indeed exceptional and unusual and defies conventional wisdom. I got to see the latest rendition of the phenomenon last Thursday careful to recognize GOP night in Cincinnati.

a new job. Thus a caucus was summoned to anoint a successor, at least until the election of 2020 when the normal ballot box process will render the verdict.

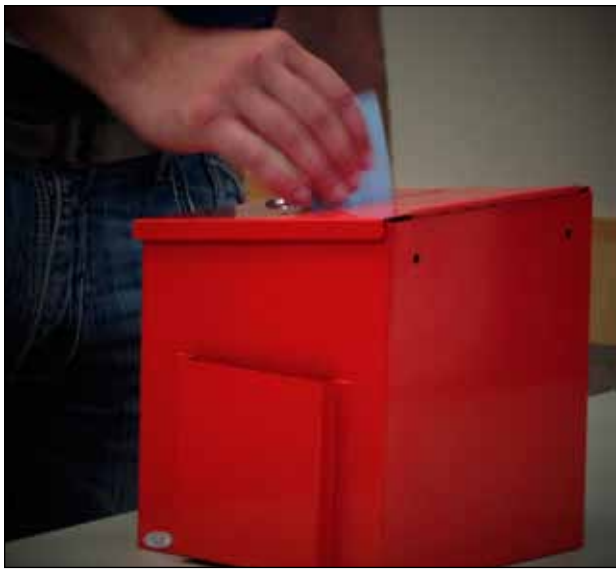
There are 59 voting precincts within the district, 40 in Grant County and 19 scattered across Blackford, Wells and Delaware counties; 59 men and women committed enough to the political party and process that they put the names on the ballot and were elected as precinct commitment. Forty-nine of them came to cast their vote in the caucus held in the conference center at the Ivy Tech Community College east of Marion.

This caucus was of large enough interest that it drew some non-voting Republican marquee names from around the state. Kyle Hupfer, the top professional gunslinger in the state party, the party chairman, was there to preside. Mitch Harper, a perennial figure on the GOP scene in Fort Wayne, came to deliver the invocation. Travis Holdman, state senator who represents a portion of Grant County, was there. So was Sen. Andy Zay. Both were in the non-voting cheap seats at the back of the room.

Some came more to be seen than to see. Former Sen. Mike Delph from Carmel, who is widely believed to be a candidate for the soon-to-be-vacated Fifth District Congressional seat held by Susan Brooks, was there.

Three candidates stood for election: John Lancaster, a former Blackford County sheriff; Steve Henderson, a Marion City councilman recently rejected by Republican voters as a candidate for mayor of Marion; and Ann Vermilion, a Marion resident and former executive at Marion General Hospital.

Hupfer, a former Mitch Daniels and Mike Pence loyalist who once headed the Indiana Department of Natural Resources, presided. He told the committeemen (and -women; it was about an even split) how the show would go. Each candidate would be

introduced by the person of their choice. Vermilion chose Grant County GOP chairman Darren Reese to speak on her behalf. Politics being what it is, ironies abound. Reese and Vermilion opposed each other as candidates a couple of years ago for the state senate seat that was won by Huntington resident Andy Zay in a similar caucus to fill the seat left by Jim Banks when he went off to Washington to be a congressman.

Each of the three was given three minutes to sell themselves to the 49 voters. Each said about what you would expect them to say in three minutes. Pleasantries without specifics.

A secret ballot followed, complete with a steel, locked ballot box which was never out of the sight of an attendant from the state GOP.

Occupants of the five rows of clearly labeled voters' chairs filed to the ballot area. A sheriff, a former mayor, county office holders of all sorts, politi-

cal junkies, and men and women who simply believe that people have to step up if the system is to work took their turns.

No rancor, no overt campaigning. That had been done earlier by the trio of candidates. Vermilion later said she had had a personal conversation with each eligible voter in the previous couple of weeks. That's 59 phone calls.

Hupfer returned to the podium.

"We have a new representative from District 31: Ann Vermilion.

She turned and gave her husband Aaron a kiss. Then she stood up, greeted well-wishers and said her thanks.

"That concludes the business of this caucus," Hupfer said.

A hand-written tally sheet from the voting lay on a table: Lancaster, 3. Henderson, 10. Vermilion, 36.

The ballot box attendant returned the box to its packaging and folks filed out of the hall.

Pursuant to the laws of the Indiana General Assembly, notice is hereby given that the following described property is listed for sale for delinquent taxes and/or special assessments. The county auditor and county treasurer will apply on or after 08/30/2019 for a court judgment against the tracts or real property for an amount that is not less than the amount set out below and for an order to sell the tracts or real property at public auction to the highest bidder, subject to the right of redemption. Any defense to the application for judgment must be filed with the Grant County Superior 1 Court and served on the county auditor and treasurer before 08/30/2019. The court will set a date for a hearing at least seven (7) days before the advertised date of sale and the court will determine any defenses to the application for judgment at the hearing. The county auditor and the county treasurer are entitled to receive all pleadings, motions, petitions, and other filings related to the defense to the application for judgment.

Such sale will be held on 09/18/2019 at the County Complex, Council Chambers and that sale will continue until all tracts and real property have been offered for sale.

Property will not be sold for an amount which is less than the sum of:

(A) the delinquent taxes and special assessments on each tract or item of real property; and (B) the taxes and special assessments on the real property that are due and payable in the year of the sale, whether or not they are delinquent; and (C) all penalties due on the delinquencies, and (D) an amount prescribed by the county auditor that equals the sum of:

(1) thirty-five dollars (\$35) for postage and publication costs; and (2) any other costs incurred by the county that are directly attributable to the tax sale; and (E) any unpaid costs due under IC 6-1.1-24-2(c) from a prior tax sale.

No property listed below shall be sold if, at any time before the sale, the Total Amount for Judgment is paid in full. If the real property is sold in the tax sale, the amount required to redeem such property will be 110% of the minimum bid for which the tract or real property was offered at the time of sale, if redeemed not more than six (6) months after the date of sale, or 115% of the minimum bid for which the tract or real property was offered at the time of sale, if redeemed more than six (6) months after the date of sale, plus five percent (5%) per annum interest on the amount by which the purchase price exceeds the minimum bid on the real property plus five percent (5%) per annum interest on the amount by which the purchase price exceeds the minimum bid on the property. All taxes and special assessments upon the property paid by the purchaser subsequent to the sale, plus five percent (5%) per annum interest on those taxes and special assessments, will also be required to be paid to redeem such property.

In addition, IC 6-1.1-25-2 (e) states the total amount required

for redemption may include the following costs incurred and paid by the purchaser or the purchaser's assignee or the county before redemption: (1) The attorney's fees and cost of giving notice under IC 6-1.1-25-4.5; (2) The costs of title search or examining and update the abstract of title for the tract or item of real property. The period of redemption shall expire on Friday, September 18, 2020 for certificates sold in the tax sale. For certificates struck to the county, the period of redemption may expire Thursday, January 16, 2020.

If the tract or item of real property is sold for an amount more than the minimum bid and the property is not redeemed, the owner of record of the property who is divested of ownership at the time the tax deed is issued may have a right to the tax sale surplus.

The Auditor and Treasurer specifically reserve the right to withhold from the sale any parcel which has been listed in error, or which otherwise becomes ineligible for sale either prior to 09/18/2019 or during the duration of the sale.

This notice of real property tax sale, and the tax sale itself are undertaken and will be conducted pursuant to the requirements of the laws of the State of Indiana which regulate the sale of land for delinquent taxes, pursuant to I.C. 6-1.1-24-1 et seq.

rounding area. The building, if it happens, may be more “civic center” than high school “auditorium.”

That’s the consensus from Gas City Mayor Larry Leach and Mississinewa schools Supt. Tab McKenzie.

The two issued a joint press release last week, outlining their plan for a \$10 million facility that would meet the needs of the school system and put Gas City and Mill Township on the map as an entertainment venue about halfway between Indianapolis and Fort Wayne along Interstate 69.

“This is way beyond a school auditorium,” McKenzie said.

The statement from the education and government leaders confirmed what others in the area have been speculating on for several months: An auditorium to seat about 1,200 people may be on the drawing board and may happen in the next couple of years.

Speaking last week, both men said they envision the building being ready for occupancy as soon as late 2020, if all goes well.

Here at Grace we have several different services each week (you can find them listed on our website, www.graceccmarion.com). On Wednesday evening at 6 pm we have a mid-week Bible study. This service is one of my favorite times of teaching. In fact, it is one of the few times you can hear me teach for the entire service. Recently, we started a new study of the book of Malachi. # Need proof that times have changed? Look at Playboy

Bob Dylan was more correct way back then than even he might have imagined: The times, they are a-changing.

If you seek the evidence for such a statement, search no farther than that venerable journal of our misspent youth, Playboy magazine. It came in the '50s and '60s and thrived in the '70s, '80s, and '90s. It got us, we of the generation of Vietnam and Watergate and JFK and Martin Luther King, Jr., and, yes, Gloria Steinem, from our adolescence to adulthood and into late middle age, always—ALWAYS—assuring questioners and skeptics that we bought the magazine only for the articles. Indeed, there were photographs of naked women in there? Really? We hadn't noticed. Too consumed by the articles, don't you know.

The interviews. Indeed, I was so dull that I really did read the interviews. Anyone who was anyone got interviewed at length and in depth in those days, and they were excellent by any standard. Why, it was in the Playboy magazine interview that Jimmy Carter confessed to lust in his heart. Jimmy Carter, he of Sunday school fame in Plains, Georgia, consented to the Playboy interview.

Then, of course, there came a time in all of our chauvinistic male lives that we dropped our annual subscription. Inquisitive kids in the house, changing interests in our lives, new standards in the world outside.

"Hef"—Hugh Hefner, the man who made the plan for the Playboy empire while sitting at the kitchen table in his cheap Chicago apartment—became a sad, old caricature of himself, batting around his mansion in silk pajamas, lugging his ever-present pipe while searching for scantily clad young women at poolside.

His daughter, a smarter business person than Hef

had ever been, quietly took away the car keys and the checkbook, assuming control over what was left of the old days, which, by the early years of this century, wasn't much.

We were kind of ashamed of ourselves, we guys who had leered and lusted, and when Christie Hefner announced that clothing would be the order of the day henceforth at Playboy, we were quietly, maybe, a bit pleased.

The internet, of course, had begun to harbor squalor beyond even our most lurid fantasies from youth. Playboy magazine or whatever was left of it pretty much went away,

along with all those other artifacts of a time now gone. That was followed by the #MeToo movement which, some of us will argue, slipped over into an orgy of excess, just like the French Revolution became awash in blood as it tried to right some wrongs.

Now, all these years later, we find that Playboy magazine has found new life in a new time with a new staff, mainly women and mostly young.

The articles have returned, albeit with a new and sharper edge. While understated photographs of undraped women have returned, the message seems to be: Those who lurk and leer need not apply. As Mr. Justice Stewart put it in defining what is beyond the pale, "I know it when I see it."

The magazine was quietly relaunched this year, this time as a thick-stock, matte-paper without advertising and publishing but four times a year.

The result is a magazine that is virtually unrecognizable from the one Mr. Hefner created, but, of course it is circulating in a world that is virtually unrecognizable from the one Mr. Hefner inhabited. And, under new ownership: for the first time no one named Hefner is involved.

# Bringing the Bard to the people

The first night in July that Hoosier Shakes presented Othello as part of the opening ceremonies for Marion's new Fifth Street Commons, three street kids rode up on their bicycles.

"They are probably in the fifth or sixth grade, and they ride their bicycles all over town. They are just kids, and they act like kids," said Dr. Greg Fiebig, the founder and executive director of Hoosier Shakes. "But something caught their eye. It might have been the sword fighting in Othello."

"They put their bikes down and came over and sat in the corner so they could see the stage. They sat there for 45 minutes, and then they got up and left. All three of them came back the next night, sat on the side of the front row and stayed for the entire production of As You Like It," Fiebig said.

But wait, there is more.

"One of the three youths, who had watched the first 45 minutes of Othello two days earlier, returned the third day, so he could watch the entire production. He sat in the center of the front row," Fiebig said. "After the program ended, he came up to me afterwards to ask what he could do to help us pack up."

Although Fiebig didn't specifically say so, that clearly was one of his most treasured memories of a summer season

during which Hoosier Shakes presented the two Shakespeare plays 16 times in Marion, Fairmount and Wabash.

It was the fourth summer season for the non-profit repertory company that produces outdoor theater with simple staging practices and live music. This year's cast consisted of 14 people, including four professional actors from around the country, four area college students and a mix of local performers. Fiebig directs the productions.

There is no admission charge for any of the Hoosier Shakes productions. "I am one of those people who believes that the arts should be public, not private. Shakespeare is meant to be performed, not read. The moment you put a dollar amount on a ticket you prohibit some people from coming," Fiebig said.

Not that Hoosier Shakes could not use the money, though. "Even though our productions are free, I keep reminding people that they are not cheap," Fiebig said.

Hoosier Shakes grew out of a \$3 million grant proposal, written by Fiebig six years ago, that actually netted him only \$500.

"IWU invited faculty members to submit proposals for a \$3 million grant from Lilly Endowment. I worked with the American Shakespeare Center in Virginia and wrote a grant, but the university vetting committee chose not to move forward with the proposal," Fiebig said. "But they gave us \$500 and said, 'This is a good idea. You need to pursue this.'"

Fiebig accepted the challenge and assembled a diverse board of directors and other

In the short but successful tenure of Eastbrook Panthers girls soccer, the 2018 season was their best one yet. Under first-year Head Coach Jamie Hallis, the Panthers won 17 games, their most in program history, and advanced to the Class 1A regional final, their

best-ever finish.

Striker Sarah Foulk, one of the county’s most gifted and talented players, put together a season for the ages. Her 51 goals in 2018 not only broke the single-season goal record at Eastbrook, but also set a new Grant County record. The Panthers’ star averaged 2.7 goals a game, while also finishing with 11 assists and 113 total points.

The Panthers’ strong supporting cast of Natalie Danals, Johwen McKim, Natalie Lakanen, and Naomi Diller each played excellent soccer

as well, combining to score 30 goals, while Danals and Lakanen recorded 15 and 13 assists, respectively.

In goal, Gabby Scott made 96 saves and allowed just eight goals in her sophomore campaign.

In 2019, all of those players will be back, solidifying themselves as not only one of the best teams in the area, but one of the best in the entire state of Indiana.

While the Panthers were successful last year, all teams have skills to improve on and areas in which they could

perform better. Eastbrook is a technically sound group. They move the ball well, pass the ball skillfully, and give themselves plenty of scoring opportunities.

Now, for the Panthers, it is all about refinement.

“I am really going to be pushing on our offense, and even a little on the defense, that they each can play each of the positions,” Hallis said. “I want them...to constantly rotate if needed, and feel comfortable stepping into all of those positions. I am really hoping we will see more of

that this year. They are all so good on the ball, and they all see the field so well.”

After a record-breaking 2018 season, Hallis believes that Foulk has gotten even better throughout the offseason, and believes that she will once again be a force to be reckoned with this fall. “I think she is continuing to improve,” Hallis said. “She was able to play club in Indianapolis this past year, so I know that was a really good experience for her.”

While the Eastbrook offense was tremendous all last

year, it could be argued that the defense was their best asset. Shauna Singer, Grace Brown, Rachel Manning, and Riya Patel were the backbone of a sturdy back line, keeping the field clean in front of Scott and limiting opposing scoring chances.



Hallis said she just wants her girls to play their best soccer on a consistent basis. If they do that, then the sky is the limit for this team. "I will expect a lot from the girls, because they do have a lot of talents and we are returning almost everybody," Hallis said. "I just hope they come in and they work really hard and that they are utilizing all the talent that they have.

### Marion

Last year at this time, Marion Head Coach Jacob Boggs was thrown into the fire, taking the reins of the Giants girls soccer team right before the season began, but that late start did not stifle the Giants' success in 2019.



Under Boggs, Marion tallied 11 wins before coming up short against Western in the sectional final. While there were ups and downs throughout the campaign, the Giants' potential shined through, making them a tough team to beat when on their game.

In a year of record-break-

ing performances, striker Taylor Kitts put together one of the finest seasons in Marion girls soccer history, scoring a school-record 37 goals and averaging 2.3 goals per contest. With Kitts returning for her senior year, together with an ever-improving group of veterans and incoming talent, the Giants have a repeat opportunity to succeed in 2019.

Heading into his first full offseason, Boggs and the Giants have concentrated on better spacing and stronger defense. While Marion's offense was potent, they suffered defensive setbacks at a higher rate than Boggs would have liked.

While there is still work to be done, Boggs believes that the girls are starting to grasp

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the concepts being taught to them. “We played with a lot of older players this summer,” Boggs said. “They got to see, as the games progressed, that those are the things that they need to be focusing on...not chasing [the ball] all over the place. That was a real focus--so we could be more positionally sound.”

Kitts will be the focal point of the offense once again in 2019, but throughout off-season workouts, senior Claire Hendricks has been really impressive, and Boggs believes she will play an even bigger role in 2019. “She grew so much last year,” Boggs said. “Taylor was obviously dominant, but Claire really stood out...She’s putting all of her shots on frame. This is going to be Claire’s year.”

Alex Riggs and Ellie Vermilion return to lead the Giants’ back line, while freshman Kaylin Burke, whom Boggs called “a mini Taylor,” has the potential to carve out

a big role for herself in the coming campaign.

The Giants also solidified their goalkeeper depth, adding Wabash transfer Olivia Lindsay. After using three goalkeepers over the course of last season, Boggs hopes that Lindsay will help to provide stability. “She’s got that hunger and that mindset,” Boggs said of Lindsay. “She’s got all the skills. She reads the game well, she comes out and commands her box, and she has good foot skills.”

On paper, the Giants have a solid core and a talented group that has a chance to be even better in 2019. If they play to their potential, Boggs believes that the Giants can compete with any team on any given day. “I’ve seen them grow so much,” Boggs said. “I think we are going to be better off than we were last year. I believe that if the girls do everything I ask of them, we can beat any team on any day.”

While the Mississinewa In-

dians only finished with four wins a season ago, they were a much better team than their 2018 record indicated. Despite one of their top players missing most of the season due to various ailments, and despite fielding a team that did not possess much soccer experience coming in, the Indians made tremendous strides in 2018, improving drastically as the season progressed and forming a solid nucleus of talent.
