

NOTICE OF APPLICATION FOR FEDERAL LAND
AND WATER CONSERVATION FUNDS FOR CONSTRUCTION
OF DOG PARK

The residents of the City of Marion, Indiana and all other interested parties are hereby notified that the Marion Department of Parks and Recreation and the Marion Park Board have filed a grant application with the Indiana Department of Natural Resources requesting Federal LWCF funds for use in the construction of a new public dog park in the City of Marion, Indiana.

The dog park will be constructed on a 2.6-acre parcel owned by the City of Marion and located on the east side of Marion between 1st and 2nd Streets and Sweetser and Flynn Streets just off State Road 18 West coming into the downtown area. The project also includes cleaning up approximately 13 acres of land adjacent to the proposed dog park involving the removal of tree stumps, old building foundations and driveways to create a large multi-purpose green space. The project involves construction in an AE Floodway zone.

Marion residents and any other interested parties may attend and provide input on the proposed project at the next meeting of the Marion Park Board scheduled for Monday, October 7, 2019, at 12:00 noon in the Second Floor Conference Room, Marion Municipal Building, 301 S. Branson Street, Marion, Indiana.
