On-My-Way Pre-K still available

Even with summer in full swing, it is never too early to be thinking about the upcoming school year.

For those looking for a quality Pre-K program in Grant County, there are still plenty of seats available through Indiana’s On-My-Way Pre-K.

On-My-Way Pre-K, a free pre-kindergarten which helps children build a foundation of skills, knowledge, and confidence, awards grants to low-income families so that they may have access to a high-quality pre-K program the year before they begin kindergarten.

Along with helping prepare children for



kindergarten, On-My-Way Pre-K provides a variety of other benefits. Family co-pays are waived during the pre-K year, families are able to choose the learning option that works best for them, and each program offers family engagement activities to help parents feel that they are a part of their children’s learning.


Furthermore, all On-

My-Way Pre-K programs keep families informed of their child’s progress along the way. For families to qualify, first, their child must be four years old by August 1, 2020, and plan to start kindergarten in the 2021/22 school year. The child must live in a household with an income below 127 percent of the federal poverty level, and parents or guardians must be working, going to school, or attending job training. IWU joins Common App for 20-21 application season

Beginning Aug. 1, 2020, new freshmen and transfer students applying to Indiana Wesleyan University (Marion) will have the ability to do so through the Common App.

Common App is a non-profit member organization dedicated to access, equity, and integrity in the college admissions process. By participating in the Common App, IWU will be able to offer a streamlined college application experience for students interested in applying to multiple institutions. Through the Common App, students and those who support

students will have access to various resources including financial aid and scholarship information, virtual mentors, and a vast library of counselor resources available in English and Spanish.

Beginning Aug. 1, 2020, students will be able to create a Common App account and their account will roll over from year to year. IWU’s part-

nership with Common App will include both application options for first-year and transfer student populations. IWU will also continue to offer students the IWU application, which is currently open for both fall 2020 and fall 2021 applications. As a reflection of IWU’s commitment to access in the college admissions process, neither the IWU application nor Common App will have an application fee. Both applications will be able to be access through indwes.edu/undergraduate.
