School

Specific requirements for a return to school are based on CDC and ISDH (Indiana State Department of Health) guidelines, and a return to school after documented infection should be directed by the individual's health care provider.

For those more comfortable with a home-learning option, the Giant Online Academy will provide enhance home learning activities and instruction.


"With continued concerns and uncertainty that COVID-19 brings, Marion Community Schools knows that many families may want a home learning option for the 2020-21 school year," the release continued. "We also know that in the event of any needed school closures, we need a more systematic approach to home learning. For those reasons, we are expanding our Giant Online Academy."

Students will be assigned a school iPad for educational use and will have exposure to grade level curriculum based on MCS curriculum maps and the Indiana Academic Standards. Marion Community School teachers will be able to connect with their students, provide weekly feedback, and provide tailored interventions when needed.

While enrolled in the Giant Online Academy, students will be expected to complete specific instructional activities and assessments.

Giant Online Academy will require a strong commitment from the student and family. In order to be effective, virtual learning requires frequent communication and interaction between the teacher, student, and parent(s)/guardian(s)," the release stated. "It is essential that students keep up with assignments, attend all scheduled Google Meets (video conferencing), respond to feedback provided by the teacher, and complete projects in a timely manner."

For those who intend to start the year off in the Giant Online Academy, the enrollment form must be completed by July 22.
