Vermilion Group completes important research to fight COVID-19

Over the summer, the Vermilion Group, in conjunction with a panel of physicians and the Grant County Health Department, took a deep dive into how COVID-19 has affected Grant County over the last five months, discovering trends and compiling important data in an effort to inform the fight against the deadly disease.

The goal of the research was to find which groups of people were most affected by the virus and which populations were being hospitalized. Those findings were coupled with a behavioral analysis survey to determine patterns of people's healthcare practices, their frequency of travel, and their social distancing practices throughout the pan-

The study featured four pillars: provide asymptomatic testing, determine behaviors during the pandemic and their relationship to the spread of the virus, interview both symptomatic and asymptomatic patients, reveal behavorial trends, and provide a student enrichment program.

"We wanted to couple the behavioral questionnaire with the results," said Ann Vermilion, founder and CEO of the Vermillion Group. "We wanted to get 150 asymptomatic patients. At that time, we were thinking, 'What if we have a large preponderance of asymptomatic that are positive?' We wanted to ascertain their behaviors, how much they socially distanced, and if they stayed inside during the quarantine. We thought this would be really good information because the Health Department's responsibility is to reduce mitigation. We want to reduce the amount of transmission as possible."

The core research, which included developing the behavioral questionnaire and then analyzing the data, was conducted by four

Grant County students, including former Marion Giants Leilanu Jackson and Ellie Vermilion. A larger group of about 11 students worked to make the testing sites run smoothly, all while meeting the needs of their clientele.

The first part of the study looked at all of the cases of COVID-19 in Grant County dating all the way back to March, when the first case was reported, up to August 3. As of that date, there have been 507 positive cases in Grant County, but only 29 deaths have been reported.

Of those 29 deaths, 19 of them came from the Colonial Oaks Health Care Center outbreak, which saw 58 residents and 37 staff members contract the virus.

In total, no one under the age of 60 has died from COVID-19 in Grant County. Of the fatalities, 69 percent were in the 80-plus range, while 24.1 percent were in the 70-79 age range. Additionally, of the first 128 cases, 76 percent of those infected were a patient or an employee of a healthcare facility.

"What we found was they were all in the age categories of mostly 70 and up, and almost all of them had underlying health conditions," Vermilion said. "We wanted to be sure we were using that message to just communicate to those who are in that category in Grant County. We want to reduce the mitigation and the spread, but we don't want anyone dying, and we don't want to overrun the hospitals."

According to Vermilion, one of the most useful parts of the research came in the form of the positive patient interviews. In total, seven patients, ranging from those in critical care to those who were asymptomatic, were interviewed.

"We felt that they had a voice," Vermilion said. "Telling their story allowed
