Foundation has been addressing in many ways since 2015. Therefore, the addition of this impact investment will simply be another layer of support for our community that will greatly complement the annual grantmaking we do to bolster the important work being done by multiple local non-profit organizations."

Afena will manage the alternative payday lending program and use their specific lending knowledge to develop the loan terms and under-writing criteria, as well as designate a certified loan officer as a program ambassador. This staff member will be primarily responsible for meeting families where

they are, such as schools, workplaces, local nonprofits, etc., and removing barriers to accessing the program. The program will also include financial coaching for all loan recipients. As the loans are paid back, Afena will be able to reinvest the available funding to assist even more families in need.

"It is the philosophy of Afena Federal Credit Union to work with our members to improve their financial health", said Karen Madry, President/CEO of Afena. "In other words, our focus is not on making loans, but putting our members in a better financial position."
