After both teams punted on their opening possessions, Stamps rushed four times for 38 yards on the Giants' next drive, including a 19-yard touchdown run to increase Marion's lead to 22-13.

The Giants' defense made their biggest stand of the night as the third quarter winded down. Starting at their own 39-yard line, the Titans drove all the way down to the Marion 29-yard line, putting them in prime position to cut into
