From that moment on, the Giants never trailed.

While Marion’s offense struggled to find much more success in the first half, their defense kept them in control. For the game, the Giants allowed just 138 yards through the air and 108 yards on the ground.

Along with keeping the Arsenal Tech offense grounded, Marion’s defense also contributed on the scoreboard. Early in the second quarter, the Titans fumbled a lateral, and Ty Coleman was right there to pick it up, rumbling 35 yards to the house. Josh Balfour converted the following two-point conversion, giving the Giants a 15-7 lead.

The Titans found the end zone again late in the first half, but the Giants’ defense held on Arsenal Tech’s two-point conversion.

In the final two quarters, Stamps single handedly helped the Giants put the Titans away. After compiling just 58 yards on 10 carries in the first half, Marion’s senior running back exploded for 127 yards and two touchdowns on just eight carries after halftime.

After both teams punted on their opening possessions, Stamps rushed four times for 38 yards on the Giants’ next drive, including a 19-yard touchdown run to increase Marion’s lead to 22-13.

The Giants’ defense made their biggest stand of the night as the third quarter winded down. Starting at their own 39-yard line, the Titans drove all the way down to the Marion 29-yard line, putting them in prime position to cut into
