

Hands of Hope announces topics for Domestic Violence Awareness month

With Domestic Violence Awareness month now officially underway, Hands of Hope, a division of Family Service Society in downtown Marion, announced their virtual support group topics, which will be held two days a week throughout the month of October.

While in years past these meetings would have been held in person, the ongoing COVID-19 pandemic has

forced Hands of Hope to hold these meetings virtually, which provides a set of challenges.

"It's been hard to get these virtual groups off the ground," Hands of Hope Director Linda Wilk said. "It can be better, because it can give someone the mobility. However, I think a lot of people like to be in person so they can see everybody and communicate that way.

"It's also a challenge for

those that have children. Now they're at home, their kids are there, and in some situations, the abuser may be at home. That limits some people[from] join[ing] because of those barriers that have now been created."

However, Wilk and her team at Hands of Hope are dedicated to helping mem-

bers of the Grant County community who are affected every day by domestic violence.

"We want to educate them about some of the different topics surrounding domestic violence, empower them, and encourage them that they are not
