Investigation

Elbert indicated she was not injured in the crash. Due to the cold outside temperature, an Upland Police officer offered to let Elbert sit in the front seat of his police car to stay warm as the crash investigation was conducted.

She accepted the offer and sat in the front passenger seat of the police car. When medics arrived on scene, Elbert told them she

was not injured and refused medical treatment.

As officers were conducting an inventory of the Chevrolet in preparation for it to be towed from the scene, they heard a gunshot. Elbert allegedly shot herself with a handgun she had retrieved from her purse.

Medics were summoned back to the scene and, despite lifesaving efforts, Elbert was pronounced dead.
