Works and Public Safety to perform those duties. At the end of the day, what I’m very, very concerned about is that we are doing things that are going to be problematic in the end and create additional legal and other hardships for the cities if we continue down this path and these issues are

challenged. We are seeking ordinances to do something that I think challenges what the state statute says. We are trying to make a law that circumvents what the state statute says. I don’t want to see us in that situation, and I don’t want to see those types of situation continue in our

government.” To put a wrap on the meeting, City Council attorney Marty Harker discussed a few other state statutes, stating that the council does have authority to be able to weigh on and that the council does have authority for pre-approval process. Additionally, another statute,

according to Harker, gives the council authority over the city’s finances and the appropriation of money. “I certainly believe that what has been proposed as far as the pre-approval process falls within the legislative and fiscal authority of the council,” Harker said.

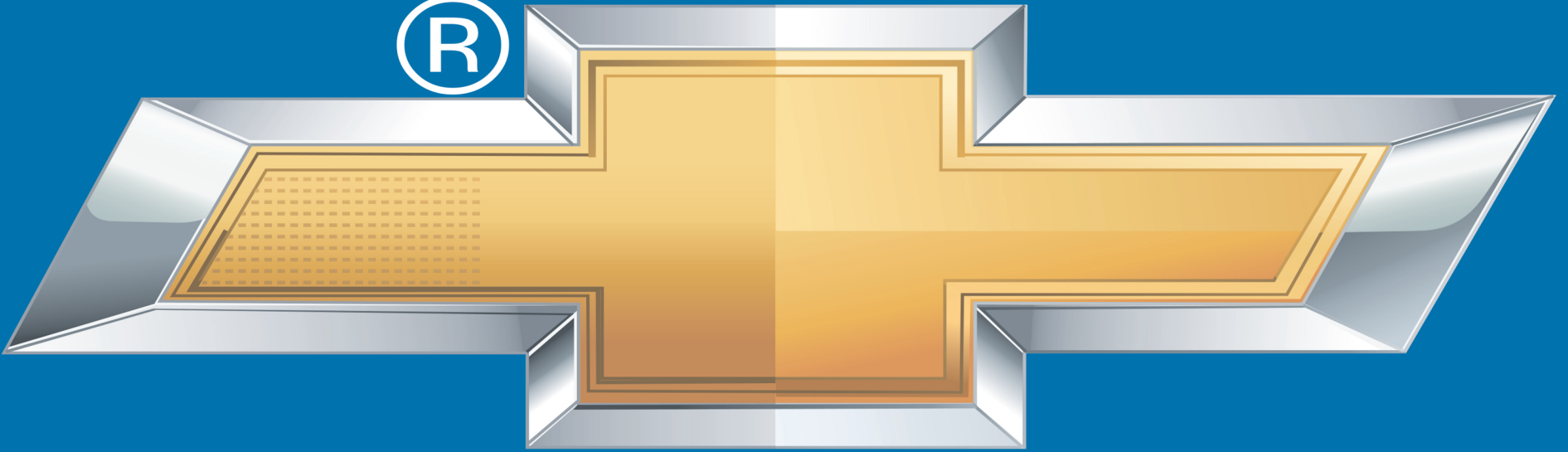
