

## Indiana Arts Commission on-ramp workshop to host in downtown Marion

Marion Design Co., in conjunction with the Marion Arts Commission, Clique Creative Services, Henrik Soderstrom Studio, and the Echo gallery, will host a three-day, on-ramp workshop in downtown Marion in mid-July.

The workshop is an effort to guide aspiring artists acquire best business practices to empower a healthy, creative economy.


“We are a collective of student interns, but also design professionals that are seeking to revitalize the city of Marion through design and collaboration,” Marion Design Company Copyrighting Intern, Isabelle Bostick stated. “We are really seeking a refreshed spirit downtown to remind people of the opportunity that is present throughout Marion and equipping them with practical ways they can be a part of that.”

“The event itself is focused on ensuring that artists understand business well enough to succeed and develop so that they can contribute to the economic growth of the community,” Marion Design Company Chief Design Officer Wendy Puffer added.

Marion was selected as one of five state-wide locations hosting an Indiana Arts Commission On-Ramp workshop for individual Indiana-based artists out of a field of a dozen communities in the state.

“We were honored to be selected,” Marion Design Company Chief Design Officer Wendy Puffer stated. “A lot of that has to be with the relationship that we’ve developed with the Indiana Arts Commission. It was a competition, and we were honored to be selected.”

The workshop for 15 accepted applicants will be held from July 15-17 from 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. each day at Lark Song, located in downtown Marion. Applicants will be selected based on the viability of the success of their

work and on what they hope to accomplish with their business.

Additionally, applicants will be selected from a variety of mediums, including dance, music, musical theatre, visual arts, graphic design, jewelry and glasswork, photography, film, audio, literary art, and much more.

Over the course of the three-day event, accepted applicants will experience:

- A three-day training workshop with practical skills for conducting a successful creative business
- A follow-up coaching session with an arts business pro
- Fellowship: Up to \$2000 applied toward your training for an art business

There will be a curriculum that is specifically designed for the entrepreneurs to help accelerate their business. The workshop will also help artists to identify strengths, while also working on weaknesses and deficits and finding ways to monetize their work in order to make a living in the world of art.

Furthermore, the workshop will also help artists to connect with one another by developing relationships and collaboration with others in similar fields.

“One of the biggest benefits will be networking,” Puffer said. “[Participants] will be able to collaborate with other artists as well as others in the business industry. They’ll not only hear from the presenters, but they’ll also hear from different panelists from all over the state that are involved in different parts of the artistic practice.”
