grants:

Early Childhood Coalition- \$6,150 to provide access to the Early Learning Hub for providers

Carey Services- \$12,000 to create an outdoor learning space for clients

YMCA- \$26,339.25 to improve the quality and add additional access to before and after school care at all 5 school systems

Family Service Society- \$20,000 to provide TRAC programing to assist with truancy and credit recovery for students

Grant Blackford Mental Health- \$25,000 to provide for in and outpatient care for the increased number of youth being seen for services

Habitat for Humanity- \$25,000 to fund the Critical Repair program

The second COVID-19 Economic Relief Initiative grant again calls for United Ways that receive funding to leverage partnerships and relationships to better meet COVID-related basic needs aligned with the social determinants of health as defined by the CDC. Specifically, United Way of Grant County plans to focus funding on programing that is addressing immediate, basic and essential needs of local communities suffering the ongoing physical, social and economic effects of the pandemic. The United Way of Grant County has \$66,785 available and is accepting funding requests from area human and social service nonprofits whose IRS designation is

in good standing beginning June 4th. Interested organizations should consult United Way of Grant County's website for

In April 2020, Lilly Endowment helped Indiana United Ways establish the

COVID-19 Economic Relief Initiative with an initial \$30 million grant. Lilly Endowment made an additional \$15 million grant in March to Indiana United Ways to support the initiative. Both grants are part of Lilly Endowment's overall grantmak-

ing to help organizations meet COVID-related needs. Since March 2020, Lilly Endowment has made grants totaling more than \$210 million to organizations working in Indiana and across the nation as they respond to the pandemic.
