As we process this truth, why would they do that? The answer is simple. There were many false prophets in that time who were wanting to lead people astray by presenting

their message, instead of God's. Not much has changed since those days. We still have a lot of false teachers. We see in Romans 16 that Paul did the same thing for Phoebe before she travelled to Corinth. These letters were a kind of a 'stamp of approval.' In II Corinthians 2, Paul referred to 'peddlers' of the Gospel for their own profit. They also carried letters.

Paul was known far and wide, and he knew that the last place on earth he would need a letter would be at Corinth. The people there were his letter because he knew them and they

visible expression of God's work, and his testimony spoke for itself. This was a powerful principle that Paul wanted to instill in the lives of the believers at the church in Corinth. This is how Paul explained it in II Corinthians 3:1-3, "(1) Do we begin again to commend ourselves? Or need we, as some others, epistles of commendation to you, or letters of commendation from you? (2) Ye are our epistle, written in our hearts, known and read of all men; (3) Forasmuch as ye are manifestly declared to be the epistle of Christ ministered by us, written not with ink but with the Spirit of the living God; not in tables of stone but in fleshy tables of the heart." We have become living letters which express the mind of Christ.

# II Corinthians 3: 1-3


Christ alone was the Author of their salvation. Each believer is a letter of Christ. People read Jesus through our lives. You could be the only Jesus that some people will ever
