She continued her education in Des Moines and then moved on to the Salvation Army two-year training program, which is very similar to a seminary program, in Chicago.

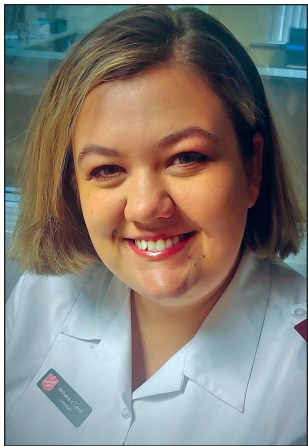

She said she also wants to explore a back-to-school program.

In addition to administration of the Citadel programs, she also will serve as pastor of the congregation that is formed by the Salvation Army.

“I preached my first sermon this past Sunday,” she said. Her seminary instructor in preaching was Capt. Blake Fewell, who headed the Marion program several years ago.
