Rejection is a terrible experience for any of us.


When we read in Scripture about our Lord Jesus, He knew first-hand what it was like to be rejected. In Luke 22:47-53 we read, (47) And while he yet spoke, behold a multitude, and he that was called Judas, one of the twelve, went before them, and drew near unto Jesus to kiss him. (48) But Jesus said unto him, "Judas, betrayest thou the Son of man with a kiss"? (49) When they who were about him saw what would follow, they said unto him, Lord, shall we smite with the sword? (50) And one of them smote the servant of the high priest, and cut off his right ear. (51) And Jesus answered, and said, "Permit ye thus far". And he touched his ear, and healed him. (52) Then Jesus said unto the chief priests, and captains of the tem-

ple, and the elders, who

were come to him, "Are you come out, as against a thief, with swords and clubs? (53) When I was daily with you in the temple, ye stretched forth no hands against me; but this is your hour, and the power of darkness". As we read from this passage, betrayal is the ultimate. How would or how could anyone betray the Lord Jesus?

Jesus' band of followers were made up of twelve disciples. It is made clear in Scripture that one of them (Judas) was a devil. You may be wondering if Jesus knew it when He selected him. Absolutely! Judas was a traitor. He was the money changer among the disciples. He was the one who carried the money purse. We must realize that many

of the disciples were weak in faith and very carnal in their apprehension of what was really taking place. They were much like men serving in an apprenticeship. They were still in the learning process and maturing in the faith. That was not the case with Judas. Judas had no spiritual depth, he was a traitor. He was one who was only acting the part. In that day he would have been called a hypocrite.

As we examine the character of Judas, he knew all about Jesus and His routine and activities. He knew where and when Jesus would move about. He betrayed our Lord into the cruel hands of the enemy for thirty pieces of silver. He always professed to be a follower, but he was never a possessor. He ultimately rejected Jesus for monetary gain.

The manner in which Judas betrayed our Lord was by a simple kiss on the cheek. He told the soldiers that they would be able to identify Jesus when he kissed Him. This was the customarily accepted token of affection in that day. However, here it is cheapened because Judas had no affection for Jesus. The amazing part of this event is how it was received. Jesus had already told the oth-

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ers in the upper room that one would betray Him, but when Judas kissed Him it was received with Lamb-like meekness. Jesus knew it was an act of betrayal, but He received it just

as His Father wanted it. Judas appeared to be united with Jesus, but his actions spoke something else. I sometimes wonder what my actions say to others. Do my actions exemplify the love

of Christ in my life, or do I betray Him by my actions? These thoughts give us much to think about, and if we need to change, I pray He will help us do it.
